Navigating the American legal system presents unique and complex challenges to our Asian clients; the language barrier is only one contributor. More crucial differences are rooted in differences in ideology, cultural and value norms. Failure to adequately identify, understand, and manage these challenges inevitably leads to unnecessary and often frustrating results for clients. Some “common sense” practices in the U.S. are not obvious to Chinese natives. Mere translation of words and phrases without appreciation and understanding of the concepts and rationales that give rise to why these words/phrases are so stated is not sufficient for clients' meaningful participation in communication with lawyers and provides inadequate assistance to clients desiring to make the right decisions. Services include:

- Explain differences between Chinese and US legal systems and enforcement, assisting clients in making appropriate decisions.
- Coordinate between clients and other law firms to minimize potential risks arising from clients' unfamiliarity with the U.S. legal system.
- Prepare native Chinese-speakers for the taking of their deposition(s) and testifying at trial, in mediation or arbitration.

Represented Matters:
